Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope this message finds you well and in good spirits. As we enter the month of June, we would like to take a moment to acknowledge and recognize two important events that hold immense significance in our nation's history and our ongoing journey towards reconciliation: Reconciliation Week and National Sorry Day.

Reconciliation Week, which takes place from May 29th to June 3rd, is a time for all Australians to come together and build relationships between the wider Australian community and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. It is a week filled with meaningful conversations, events, and activities aimed at fostering mutual respect, understanding, and recognition of the rights and cultures of First Nations peoples. This year's theme, "More than a word. Reconciliation takes action," reminds us that true reconciliation requires active engagement and commitment from all members of our society.

National Sorry Day, Friday May 26th, is a day to acknowledge and express regret for the historical mistreatment and trauma endured by the Stolen Generations. During these significant events, we encourage each and every one of you to engage in conversations, seek knowledge, and participate in activities that promote understanding, respect, and reconciliation. Here are some ways you can get involved:

Attend local events: Look out for Reconciliation Week and National Sorry Day events happening in your community. These events provide opportunities to connect with First Nations peoples, learn about their cultures, and show your support

Educate yourself: Take the time to learn about the history, culture, and experiences of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. Read books, watch documentaries, or explore online resources that provide valuable insights into their rich heritage and ongoing struggles.

Reflect and have conversations: Engage in discussions with friends, family, and colleagues about reconciliation, the Stolen Generations, and the importance of acknowledging our shared history. It is through open and respectful dialogue that we can foster understanding and promote positive change.

Remember, reconciliation is an ongoing journey that requires our collective efforts. By coming together, listening, and taking meaningful actions, we can contribute to a more just, inclusive, and reconciled Australia.

We look forward to seeing your involvement and participation during Reconciliation Week and National Sorry Day. Together, let us build a future that celebrates and respects the diversity and heritage of all Australians
