Self Control

Strong people make good choices

One of most used EQ Pillars at GSPS is Self Control. As part of our school ethos we have structured EQ lessons, anecdotal conversations, games and stored statements we share with our students.

This week's proverb '**Strong people make good choices**' has been discussed in classrooms around the topics of what does this look like in the classroom, in the yard and at home. Sharing this language between school and home helps strengthen the value and the connection between teachers, students and families. We become a united front and team.

In the classroom this EQ proverb looks and feels like respectful speaking and listening, allowing others to learn, doing the right thing even when no one is watching.

In the yard this EQ proverb looks and feels like playing by the rules of the game, staying in bounds, seeking help for social issues.

At home..... ask your children what would this EQ proverb look and feel like in your house?

Sharing the moments when we as the adults have made strong choices in our day helps our children embed the value and open the conversation of where they have also made strong choices for the day.
