Social Media Changes

This week the Year 5 students took part in a Victoria Police Education Initiative 'Think You Know'. Senior Constable Mitchell Bull came to present information and answer questions for the students. One topic that the students asked a lot of questions about was the new Social Media Bans in Australia as of 10th December 2025.

Senior Constable Bull explained to the students their rights as online citizens and also their responsibilities. This included sharing information, continually adding others into group chats, posting and inappropriate images.

With the change in Social Media parents may see behaviours that reflect the change in their child's demeanour, and it is expected they will feel frustrated and disappointed in the ban.

Expect an Adjustment Period

Many children go through a short withdrawal-like phase.

Common patterns:

- Days 1-3: frustration, increased device-seeking
- Week 1: boredom, irritability, emotional ups and downs
- Week 2+: improved mood; increased imaginative play; less device-focus

Keeping the conversation open and curious with some empathy for your child is suggested.





Nick Teague offers Guitar lessons during school time on a Tuesday.







E-Scooter and Recreational Vehicle Safety

Students and families are reminded about the safe and legal use of e-scooters and other recreational vehicles.

While riding to school is a great option for many students, please be aware that riding e-scooters (or similar recreational vehicles) on footpaths is not allowed under Council's Local Law.

Instead, students should dismount and walk their recreational vehicle through these areas.

These rules apply to all recreational vehicles including:

- · E-scooters
- ·Bikes
- · Skateboards
- · Rollerblades
- · Monkey bikes
- · Motorised go-karts
- · Other petrol or battery-powered recreational vehicles

Victoria Police will be working with Council to monitor these areas – their focus is on keeping everyone safe and ensuring riders know the rules.
