Navigating the Online world with your child is a complex and difficult task at times. Below are the new reforms to come into play. A more in-depth explanation is available through the eSafety Commissioners website.

While there are no exact figures for "primary aged children," data for children aged 8–12 shows they spend an average of 1.5 hours per day on social media platforms. Some studies show this can be higher for some age groups, with older children averaging over three hours a day.

As a school we support the changes and talk to students about being Healthy online citizens.

From December 10, 2025, many social media platforms in Australia will be restricted for users under 16, requiring them to take "reasonable steps" to prevent underage accounts.

What this means for under-16's

- Account restrictions: Starting December 10, 2025, platforms that meet certain criteria will be required to prevent people under 16 from creating or keeping accounts.
- Purpose of the law: The goal is to *protect young people from negative effects on their stress levels, sleep, and concentration*. The eSafety Commissioner also states it will give young people more time to develop their social, emotional, and digital skills before using social media.
- **List of affected platforms:** The restrictions will apply to many popular platforms, such as Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, X, and YouTube.
- **Platforms likely excluded:** Some platforms will not be subject to the ban, such as Discord, WhatsApp, and YouTube Kids, although the list of included and excluded platforms can change.
- What to do: Young people and parents can visit the <u>eSafety Commissioner's website</u> for more information and to find practical resources to help them navigate the changes.

Phones / iPad in the Yard

Students are not permitted to use their phones or iPads in the school grounds and we request the parents are not sharing content with students in the school grounds also. Our aim is to keep all students safe and responsible online citizens.


Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) for 2026

A recent Victorian Government announcement regarding BYOD states that school must no longer invite families to purchase or bring their own devices to school in Years F-6. Guthrie Street Primary School has chosen to cease our BYOD program starting next year, 2026.

This news item is being sent to families who have a child in Grade 2 or 3 in 2026 to inform families that we do not require you to provide a BYOD iPad for the commencement of 2026 school year.

Note for families who have students currently in Grade 2,3,4 and 5. Students who already own a device and bring this to school can continue to do so until they finish primary school.

E-Scooter and Recreational Vehicle Safety

Students and families are reminded about the safe and legal use of e-scooters and other recreational vehicles.

While riding to school is a great option for many students, please be aware that riding e-scooters (or similar recreational vehicles) on footpaths is not allowed under Council's Local Law.

Instead, students should dismount and walk their recreational vehicle through these areas.

These rules apply to all recreational vehicles including:

- · E-scooters
- ·Bikes
- · Skateboards
- · Rollerblades
- · Monkey bikes
- · Motorised go-karts
- · Other petrol or battery-powered recreational vehicles



Victoria Police will be working with Council to monitor these areas – their focus is on keeping everyone safe and ensuring riders know the rules.
